Who Are We?

An association representing over 150 members in Alberta public health practice and research. Membership is open to any individual engaged in public health and/or who self-identifies as having an interest in public health.

 - Alberta Recreation and Parks Association
 - Canadian Cancer Society
- 3. Membership engagement through email, newsletters, the website, and an annual general meeting

Who Are We Looking For?

- 1. Individuals with public health interest or expertise that can support the strategic direction of the Association.
- 2. We seek board diversity and a set of skills and experience that are underrepresented in the current Board:
 - Rural public health research or practice
 - Private sector and industry
 - Finance, legal/risk, fundraising and grant writing
 - Student or late/post career stage
